ESTABLISHED CLUB CUSTOMS

These customs or guidelines have been established by the Club to protect the Club facilities and promote the enjoyment and safety of all children. Everyone is encouraged to support the customs listed below. Please refer to the Mayacama Golf Club Membership Plan for additional Rules & Regulations.

PROPER ATTIRE & ETIQUETTE - GOLF

Children must observe the established customs of proper golf attire and golf shoes. Shirts with collars and sleeves, slacks or Bermuda-length shorts are considered appropriate attire for boys. The same is appropriate for girls with the addition of golf dresses or skirts. Children under the age of 16 are not allowed to use the golf facilities unless supervised by an adult. Golf clubs may be provided upon request.

PROPER ATTIRE & ETIQUETTE - SWIMMING POOL AREA

Swimsuits must be worn at all times by all individuals using the swimming pool. Cut-offs and shorts are not permitted. Children should not be changed or dressed on the pool deck. Please use the appropriate locker room and shower prior to swimming. Diving, running, pushing, dunking, or chewing gum is not permitted. Children are to bring sun hats, swimsuits, sunscreen, and water wings for beginner swimmers. The Club provides towels.

PROPER ATTIRE & ETIQUETTE - TENNIS COURTS

Proper tennis attire shall be worn at all times by all individuals at the tennis facility and shall consist of proper tennis shoes (non-marking or white-soled shoes) and apparel manufactured expressly for tennis. In cold weather, sweatshirts and warm-ups are acceptable. Cutoffs, blue jeans, street trousers, tank tops (boys), football jerseys, Hawaiian shirts, exposed sport bras or swimsuits are not permitted. Children under the age of 16 are not allowed to use the tennis courts unless supervised by an adult. Chewing gum is not permitted. Tennis rackets may be provided upon request.

TRANSPORTATION

Club provided transportation for field trips is included in field trip fees. As safety is our first concern, California State Laws regarding child passenger restraint systems must be observed. Parents must provide car seats or booster seats for children under the age of 8.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Member and guest cancellations made less than 48 hours in advance and no-shows will be charged in full. Event cancellation may occur if there are no sign-ups 48 hours in advance of the event.

PRIVATE CHILD CARE

Year around, parents may request private childcare with 48-hour advance reservations. Off property sitting will require an additional \$15 travel fee.

At this level there is no need for previous water experience. Your child will learn the basics of swimming. This class will work to help your child become comfortable putting their face in the water and blowing bubbles, kicking, retrieving objects from the bottom of the pool (3 feet), back and front float for 10 seconds, stream line with face in water and kicking, and arm strokes with face in the water with good kicking (able to swim 6 yards to move to next level).

2:15 pm - 2:45 pm LEVEL 2- STROKE READINESS

Child should be able to hold their breath (10 seconds), float (10 seconds), and swim with face in water with arm strokes for 6 yards. In this level the child will continue to build on skills.
