Gift of Spirits

Single barrel whiskey (*or single cask whisky*) is a premium class of whisky in which each bottle comes from an individual aging barrel, instead of being created by blending together the contents of various barrels to provide uniformity of color and taste. Even whiskeys that are not blends may be combined from more than one batch, or even from differing years to achieve their consistency. With Single barrel, the bottle bearing the barrel number and in most cases the dates for the beginning and end of aging. Each barrel is thought to contribute unique characteristics to the finished whiskey.

QUANTITY

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BUFFALO TRACE - \$23.40

A deep amber whiskey with complex aromas of vanilla, mint and molasses. Pleasantly sweet to the taste with notes of brown sugar and spice that give way to oak, toffee, dark fruit and anise. This whiskey finishes long and smooth with serious depth.

CHARBAY, R5 WHISKEY - \$95

A new whiskey from Northern California distilled from bottle ready Racer 5, IPA Beer from Healdsburg's Bear Republic Brewing Company. A double alambic Charentais pot still is used in the production of this fine whiskey. It is aged 29 months in used French oak and shows flavors that are malty, floral, fruity and herbaceous with hints of pine, hops, confection, lychee and dried papaya.

CARPANO ANTICA - \$30.68

This dark, mysterious vermouth is rich, complex and layered, boasting aromas of mint and other herbs, plums and figs, reminiscent of Madeira. The rich flavors are hard to pin down: cocoa, red wine, almonds, bitter marmalade, hints of spice and toffee all play across the palate, finishing with a bracing bitter edge. This delectable sweet vermouth would shine in a Manhattan.

THE BITTER TRUTH - \$20

Originally, cocktail bitters were the ingredient that distinguished cocktails from other categories of beverages. For decades, they were an essential component of good cocktail creations. The Bitter Truth Bitters were specifically designed for recreating classic drinks made true to the original recipe or for experimentation with modern cocktail creations. The Bitter Truth bitters are made the traditional way using only the best quality natural ingredients. The Bitter Truth bitters have received multiple awards and continue to innovate the bar world.

THE MAYACAMA MANHATTAN - \$64.08 PER KIT

Our house Manhattan is made with Buffalo Trace Single Barrel (hand chosen by our beverage managers), Carpano Antica and The Bitter Truth bitters. Purchase a Manhattan kit so you can enjoy our Manhattans away from the Club. Just add your own cherries.

Scotch Whiskey is often considered one of the world's most revered spirits. There are varying styles, though all can be delectable masterworks in their own right. Some are flavored heavily by peat and smoke, others are light and fruity. Coastal whiskies are often flavored by the sea and a refined salinity can be found. There is always a sweetness; sometimes in omnipresence, sometimes lurking in the substrata.

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LAGAVULIN, ISLAY - \$83.63

Lagavulin legitimately claims to be one of the oldest distilleries in Scotland, dating back to 1742. Lagavulin was awarded 97 points by the Wine Enthusiast and a Double gold at the San Francisco Spirits competition. It is rich on the palate with hints of sherry and a finish that's long and smooth. With a good hint of peat, it pairs best with strong flavors and is a favorite with cigar aficionados.

SCOTT'S SELECTION, BLADOCH 1984 - \$357.50

Robert Scott has been immersed in the Scotch Whisky trade since he left school at the age of 16. Steadily he rose through the ranks, gaining extensive knowledge of the distilling trade, becoming the Master Disteller at Speyside Distillers until his final assignment, to create a personal selection of his favorite malts, its aim is to bottle whiskies as close as possible from their original taste in the cask.

Gin is a spirit which derives its predominant flavor from juniper berries. Other botanicals often used in gin include coriander, lemon and orange peels, fennel, cassia, anise, almond and angelica. From its earliest beginnings in the Middle Ages, gin has evolved over the course of a millennium from an herbal medicine to an object of commerce in the spirits industry. Today, the gin category is one of the most popular and widely distributed ranges of spirits, and is represented by products of various origins, styles, and flavor profiles that all revolve around juniper as a common ingredient.

QUANTITY

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JUNIPERO \$32.07

The wonderful challenge for a gin distiller is in selecting and blending from a wide variety of additional, exotic botanicals in order to impart a uniquely satisfying, balanced character to his gin. Anchor Distillery has taken delight in the adventure of researching and experimenting with many such botanicals. The final formula must remain a secret, but they hope you will agree that they have achieved a distinctive, intriguing complexity in their Junipero Gin: light and crisp and clean, combining a deep and mysterious spiciness with subtle delicacy.

UNCLE VAL'S GIN - \$41.60

Uncle Val's is a small-batch botanical gin inspired by Zio Valerio's love of gardening and native tuscan cuisine. The botanicals are not only Uncle Val's favorite cooking ingredients, but also happen to make an exceptionally unique and smoothly delicious gin.

Uncle Val's presents a complex and subtly pleasing sensation of flavors. Raise your glass and you'll notice crisp aromas of sage and juniper. Your first sip will bring out a bright lemon taste, which gives way to a warm, spicy, lavender finish, softened by the coolness of cucumber. Each sip bolsters the botanical flavors, along with a continuous presence of piney juniper.
