Golf Courses:

• Greens Fees for six (6) rounds of golf with golf carts:

Valderrama (Two Rounds). Valderrama is a Robert Trent Jones design noted for the cork trees that line its fairways and for its severe changes in elevation. It was the first course outside of Britain and America to host the Ryder Cup (1997) and is a frequent venue for major international competitions. While Valderrama has many good holes, the best known is the most controversial—the dreaded par five seventeenth with a green that only a course architect could love.

La Reserva de Sotogrande (Two Rounds). La Reserva is an outstanding, relatively new Robert Cabell Robinson design. The architect had a hand in the design at Valderrama and La Reserva is reflective of his influence. Mediterranean views are available on many holes and large cork trees line the fairways adding difficulty along the lines of Valderrama. The course is quite long by modern standards though the presence of five sets of tee boxes offers golfers of all skill levels ample choices.





Real Club de Golf Sotogrande. Sotogrande was the first European course designed by Robert Trent Jones. Since it opened in 1964, it is has been considered one of the best courses in Europe. The course has very little rough, but there are plenty of bunkers and water hazards to make Sotogrande a challenging course for all levels of golfers. Accurate shots to the green are necessary on every hole as virtually every green is surrounded by bunkers. Water comes into play on the



1st, 7th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 16th, 17th and 18th holes -- and always on the right hand side.

Finca Cortesin Golf Club. Finca is the worthy new home for the World Match Play Championship. Measuring over 7600 yards from the back tees, this is one of the longest golf courses in Europe and a favourite of the big hitters. Yet, with several sets of tees, it's a course that is most enjoyable for all levels of players. The front nine winds through valleys with lovely views of the Mediterranean. The back features dramatic changes in elevation.

PAYMENTS After the personal consultation necessary to determine client preferences, The Haversham & Baker Company ("H&B") presents prospective clients with a proposed package and price quotation. The price is not subject to change provided a deposit of twenty-five percent (25%) of the price quoted is received within fifteen (15) days. A second payment ("Second Payment") equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the price quoted is due thirty (30) days after acceptance of the package and price quotation. Final payment ("Final Payment") of the remaining balance is due not less than sixty (60) days prior to the first day of the programme. The amount of the final payment is subject to change if international currency rates fluctuate more than \$0.05 from those in effect at the time of the initial quotation.

PENALTIES For each day the Second Payment or Final Payment is overdue, a twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) per person penalty will be assessed against the proposed package. If either the Second Payment or Final Payment is more than fifteen (15) days overdue, H&B cannot guarantee the continued availability of the proposed package at the price quoted.
