



2018 Adam's Vineyard Pinot Noir

Adam's Vineyard is a 9-acre parcel residing above the fog line on a rolling Forestville hillside. An endearing wine representing the warmest terroir in Lynmar's collection, this wine showcases lush notes of raspberry, fresh Santa Rosa plum and ripe red fruits, with faint hints of saffras, baking spice and cocoa powder. Bright and fresh acidity is supported by flavors of Rainier cherries, pomegranate and savory seasonings. A generous finish with hints of oak, culminates with streamlined tannins and refined structure.

2018 Quail Hill Vineyard Pinot Noir

Our 45-acre Quail Hill Vineyard is comprised of fourteen distinguished Pinot Noir clones. This signature Estate blend harmonizes the complexity of this extraordinary site and the pure, elegant expression of Russian River Valley Pinot Noir. A deep crimson color in the glass leads to notes of elderberry, blackberry pie and cocoa powder. A soft and rich entry on the palate gives hints of black tea, fresh blueberry and newly cut redwood. The textured finish reminisces with hints of blueberry, black tea and forest floor.

2018 Susanna's Vineyard Pinot Noir

A gift from our Proprietor to his wife, Susanna's Vineyard is a stunning 20-acre site along Highway 116 in Sebastopol. Though just two miles from Quail Hill, the climate is surprisingly cooler, offering a dynamic counterpoint within the Lynmar collection of wines. The 2018 Susanna's Vineyard is a wonderful elegant expression of Pinot Noir. A bright ruby color in the glass, this wine exudes vivacious aromas of Bing cherry, rose water, hibiscus flower and nectarine skin. A focused but generous texture on the palate leads way to tastes of fresh alpine strawberry, birch bark and dried cranberry which culminates with a long finish.

2018 AMDG Pinot Noir

Ad Majorem Dei Glorium (AMDG) is a philosophy of excellence from the Jesuit tradition, dedicating all effort to the greater good. The 2018 AMDG Pinot Noir celebrates Lynmar's dedication to excellence in our vineyards and winemaking. It also acknowledges the contribution of Jesuits efforts to bring learning and education throughout the world. Deep ruby in color, the AMDG brings forth juicy red fruit aromatics followed by notes of cherry cola, ripe plum and star anise. An opulent entry on the palate framed by bright acidity emits flavors of cherry kirsch, raspberry compote and baking spices which flow seamlessly into a lingering finish.
